LOS SANTOS, SA, 4/08/24 – On April 8th 2024, Officers from the Major Crimes Division, Los Santos Police Department, and Blaine County Sheriff’s Office responded to a call up at the abandoned Motel in Sandy Shores.

Once Officers arrived and started to search the area, Officers quickly became aware of a hazardous contamination scene, that was located in one of the second floor rooms of the Sandy Shores abandoned Motel on Algonquin Boulevard. Officers quickly secured the scene and hazmat officers responded to deal with this matter.

Upon processing and clearing the room, It was advised that the room would remain unsafe and could pose risk to life if left unsecured for the next few days while the room vents. Upon this advice Law Enforcement placed police tape around the building and very clear warnings on the building itself and outside the room for the general public to avoid entering.

Law Enforcement also notified the public via a Police Service Announcement:

“This is an advisory to stay clear of the abandoned motel in Sandy Shoes due to a hazardous contamination. Any individuals found on the premises are asked to see medical treatment ASAP. trespassers will be dealt with accordingly.”

It is externally important that the general public avoid this area for the next few days and if they choose to disregard this warning and continue onto the premises to seek immediate medical treatment for their health.
