With the sudden resignations of former Representatives Yukigumi Lillegard-Marino (Formerly Emilie Lillegard-Marino), Astra Lillegard-Marino, and Cassie Kendrick, the people of San Andreas are understandably concerned about whether we, the recently elected and remaining legislators, will be capable of fulfilling our roles. These concerns are not unreasonable. It is not unheard of for individuals to obtain a seat within the Legislature through special elections and make little impact.

However, It is with great pride that I inform the People that the 10th (and a half) Congress is already making great headway on all proposals and legislation. Specifics on what is being worked upon can be found within the [most recent Meeting Summary](#) of the 10th Congress. Legislators have also met with three of four potential Circuit Court prospective nominees, which are pending a review by the executive.

An internal election for leadership roles within the 10th (and a half) Congress was also conducted last Thursday, with the following individuals filling certain roles:

- Representative Yuri Devlin secured the role of Speaker of the Legislature.
- Representative Maxine Finch secured the role of Secretary of the Legislature.
- Representative Jack Burton retained the role of Treasurer of the Legislature.

As the most senior member of the Legislative Branch, Yuri Devlin has served two prior terms. Prior to being Speaker of the Legislature, he also fulfilled the role of Secretary of the Legislature back in the 7th Congress. Regarding his appointment, he stated the following:

“As Speaker of the Legislature, I will ensure that the remainder of this term is remembered for how we handled the adversity that came before us. I have devoted all of my terms to transparency and this will be no different. I make myself readily available to the citizens of San Andreas and I will ensure that the other members of the Legislature follow suit.”
