Law Updates:

In our commitment to keep people informed of new or updated laws, we would like to highlight important parts of the most recent bill that was submitted by the State Legislature and signed into law.

H.R. 359 - Workers Pay Protection Act

The new bill ensures that workers in the state of San Andreas are paid within 14 days after leaving their employment. Employers must make a good faith attempt to return owed items within this period. If the worker does not claim owed items within 60 days, they forfeit them. We encourage all to read up on this bill to be informed and stay up to date with the laws and regulations of San Andreas.

H.R. 361 - Amendment to H.R. 226 - Human Remains for Science and Education

H.R.361 was an amendment to H.R.226. This amendment was made for the purpose of adding specific regulations about the display and transportation of human remains. Along with focusing on the monitoring of the displayed human remains. We encourage all to read up on this bill to be informed and stay up to date with the laws and regulations of San Andreas.

H.R. 363 - Speedy Trial and Bail Act of 2024

H.R. 363 was introduced and repealed H.R. 215 - The Speedy Trial and Bail Act of 2022. There is a lot to unpack in this bill and we encourage everyone to read up on this bill to be informed and stay up to date with the laws and regulations of San Andreas
